

## **The Pastoral Listening Workshop**

This workshop is offered to give basic skills in intentional listening as Christians. It is offered for all those engaged with people-ministries from their parish base – pastoral care, Op Shop volunteers, welcomers, working with children and youth, community connecting ministries, etc. With a great team of trainers, including hospital chaplains and staff from Benetas and the Brotherhood of St Laurence, we are challenged through a series of practical exercises to examine how we listen and the myriad of issues to be aware of in that listening.

The workshop runs 9am-3pm, with the after lunch sessions as workshops. It is being piloted at the end of July at Dixon House, Clayton, and then will be offered throughout the Diocese, with further information available on this site.
