**MELBOURNE ANGLICAN TRUST CORPORATION AS TRUSTEE OF THE ANGLICAN DEVELOPMENT FUND ABN 16 043 119 479 – APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF AN IDENTIFICATION STATEMENT PURSUANT TO ASIC INSTRUMENT 2016/813**

I refer to your application dated 28 February 2017 on behalf of the Melbourne Anglican Trust Corporation as Trustee of the Anglican Development Fund ABN 16 043 119 479 (**MATC**) for registration of an identification statement (the **Identification Statement**).

Due to the date it was lodged, your Identification Statement was not accepted by Australian Securities and Investments Commission (**ASIC**) by 28 February 2017, as required by ASIC Corporations (Charitable Investment Fundraising) Instrument 2016/813 (the **Instrument**). Following the execution of ASIC Corporations (Amendment) Instrument 2017/359, charitable investment fundraisers are able to have their identification statements accepted at any date before 31 December 2017.

I am pleased to advise that the application to register the Identification Statement pursuant to the Instrument (as amended by ASIC Corporations (Amendment) Instrument 2017/359) has been accepted by ASIC.

Please note that this relief only applies from 8 June 2017 until 31 December 2017 for so long as MATC continues to meet the requirements in section 8 of the Instrument and the conditions in subsections 7(1) to (4) of the Instrument.

I take this opportunity to remind MATC of its obligations under the Instrument, in particular, the obligations to ensure that the Identification Statement remains up to date.

From 1 January 2018, this relief only applies for so long as MATC continues to meet the requirements in subsection 5(3) of the Instrument. Additionally, MATC must meet the conditions in section 7 of the Instrument.
