

Psalms & Readings *to go with your prayers*

The thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time is this lectionary's annual starting-point.

1/ It "changes Testaments", so for the next year we shall be reading:

Job, the second half of Isaiah, and the other prophets of the Old Testament (except Hosea), Ezra-Nehemiah, Esther, the Song of Songs, and, in the Apocrypha, 1 Maccabees; between Easter and Whitsunday we read some of the New Testament's letters.

2/ The Psalms (a note mainly for Anglicans)
Some people use the Daily Services in one of the Australian prayer books for their private devotions. In those books a few psalms are used as parts of some services, and such psalms are marked here:
