

## When is a Clearance for Service is required?

To determine if a position holder is required to have a Clearance for Service, read Schedule 1 of the [Professional Standards Uniform Regulations](#) and consider the role (and the tasks they perform), office and/or position of the individual in your parish context. The following questions could be used as a guide.

Is the role listed at Schedule 1 clause 2 of the Professional Standards Uniform Regulations?
